1. Read Matthew 6:19-24. How would you summarize the main idea? What stands out to you?
2. What is Jesus' logic for why we should lay up treasures in heaven instead of on earth? How do we do this?
3. Read Revelation 3:14-22. What leads the Laodiceans to a place of apathy? Why do you think it is so easy for this to happen to us?
4. What do you think Jesus means when he says, “where your treasure is, there your heart will be also” (vs. 21)?
5. Read 1 John 2:15-17. How is this related to what Jesus says about the eyes in verses 22-23 in his sermon?
6. In verse 24, what does Jesus mean by using the term “master”? How does his argument force you to choose where to give your loyalty and service? In what ways is God a better master than money?
7. What is one practical way you can make your Father in Heaven the treasure of your heart, the focus of your eyes, and the master of your life?
