"Everyone then who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on the rock." -Jesus

- 1. Read Psalm 111. What stands out to you most about how God is described in this Psalm?
- 2. Read Psalm 112. What stands out to you most about how the blessed person is described?
- 3. Why is it important to know whether or not God is worthy of our trust before we entrust our lives to him? What are some of the things that can happen if we try to live God's way without deciding whether or not his way is trustworthy?
- 4. Psalm 111 shows us six reasons why we can trust God: He is our creator, He is for us, He is our savior, He is our provider, He is trustworthy, and He is unchanging. Which of these reasons why God is worthy of our trust resonates with you most? Which one do you need to believe this week?
- 5. Psalm 112 shows us what it looks like to trust God with five different areas of our lives: our obedience, our family, our finances, our actions, and our circumstances. In which of these areas do you most struggle to trust God? Why?
- 6. What things are you seeking in life? Where do we most often look to satisfy those longings? How does God fully and finally provide us with the things we seek and satisfy our deepest longings?
